Claire McGuigan is the economic policy officer in Christian Aid's Latin America and Caribbean department. Her work focuses mainly on trade and investment in Latin America and the Caribbean and includes a special focus on Bolivia. She studied at Exeter University and the London School of Economics and spent 5 years living in Latin America.

In her talk Claire will examine Bolivia's economic policies, the role of Western governments and the international financial institutions in deepening the economic crisis in the country and the possibilities for future economic development and poverty reduction in Bolivia. The talk will be preceded by the showing of a recent video made by Christian Aid about privatization and the role of foreign investment in Bolivia. It features the well known British actor Damian Lewis and several Christian Aid partners in Bolivia.
