Angus Morris from the UK's Security Sector Development Advisory Team has recently returned from Bolivia where he has been working with the Government on improving the delivery of Public Order and discussing ways to transform their Security Sector. A British Government initiative jointly sponsored by the Foreign & Commonwealth Office, the Department for International Development and the Ministry of Defence, this was his fifth visit since November 2005. He was in La Paz for carnival and will share his experiences of events there as well as in the challenging area of helping the Government to improve the provision of security for the people of Bolivia.

A widely experienced Security Sector Development expert, Angus is currently involved in Sri Lanka, Sudan, Ethiopia, Kosovo and Serbia, as well as in Bolivia.
