**Richard Gott was for many years a correspondent for the Guardian in Latin America, and a reporter in Bolivia in 1967 during Guevara's final campaign. He was the editor of the Latin American Library published by Penguin Books in the 1970s, and an editor of the newsletter "Latin America". He has written extensively and is the author of "Land Without Evil", a history of the territories of Chiquitos and Mojos as revealed by travellers over 500 years, and more recently of "Cuba: A New History", published by Yale in 2004, as well as of "Hugo Chávez and the Bolivarian Revolution", published by Verso in 2005.**
