Gregorio Lanza is a former member of the Bolivian parliament and senior civil servant. He was Director General for Conflict Resolution in Carlos Mesa's government. An economist, he holds a masters degree in public policy and is currently studying Economics and Governmental Reform at the University of Westminster under a British Government scholarship.

In his talk, Gregorio Lanza will examine the underlying causes of recent political developments in Bolivia and the challenges facing the new Morales administration. Topics will include democracy and governance, privatisation, indigenous issues, the economy, the role of the British energy companies, international relations, constitutional reform and the pressures for regional autonomy.
